WHEREAS, the governor of the State of New Jersey has encouraged municipalities to enter into shared services agreements in order to be more efficient and realize greater financial savings; and

WHEREAS, N.J.S.A. 40A:65-1 et seq., the Uniform Shared Services and Consolidation Act encourages government efficiency through shared services, regionalization or consolidation; and

WHEREAS, the Borough of Lodi ("Borough") and the Lodi Board of Education ("Board") have agreed to have the Borough advertise for bids and award a contract for the collection and disposal of solid waste, vegetative waste and recyclable materials ("Solid Waste"); and

WHEREAS, the Bid Specifications for the collection and disposal of Solid Waste require the bidder to bid a separate amount for dumpster pickup for the institutional facilities operated by the Board;

WHEREAS, the parties hereto are desirous of establishing the procedure for the Board to reimburse the Borough for the cost of the dumpster pickup service at the Board's institutional facilities;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Board of Education of Lodi of the Borough of Lodi hereby authorize the entering into a Shared Services Agreement with the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Lodi which form of Agreement is attached hereto, made a part hereof and incorporated herein by reference; and

WITNESSETH:

WHEREAS, N.J.S.A. 40A:65-1 et seq., the Uniform Shared Services and Consolidation Act encourages government efficiency through shared services, regionalization or consolidation; and

WHEREAS, the Borough of Lodi ("Borough") and the Lodi Board of Education ("Board") have agreed to have the Borough advertise for bids and award a contract for the collection and disposal of solid waste, vegetative waste and recyclable materials ("Solid Waste"); and

WHEREAS, the Bid Specifications for the collection and disposal of Solid Waste require the bidder to bid a separate amount for dumpster pickup for the institutional facilities operated by the Board;

WHEREAS, the parties hereto are desirous of establishing the procedure for the Board to reimburse the Borough for the cost of the dumpster pickup service at the Board's institutional facilities.

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual covenants and promises hereinafter set forth it is agreed by the parties as follows:

- 1. The Borough shall require its solid waste contractor to provide dumpster pickup at the Board institutional facilities namely: Hilltop School, Columbus School, Wilson School, Washington School, Middle School, High School, Roosevelt School and Lincoln School.
- All containers shall be supplied by contractor, shall have lids in workable order and shall be cleaned and disinfected as needed or as reasonably determined by the Borough.
- 3. For each institutional facility, the Contractor shall provide one (1) eight yard container for solid waste, one (1) eight yard container for newspaper, magazines, and cardboard, and one (1) four yard container for recyclable materials for glass, plastic, and aluminum.
- 4. Solid waste from the above listed institutional facilities shall be picked up and transported daily Monday to Friday unless Borough authorizes less frequent pickups. Pick-up at said institutions or schools shall be between 6:00 a.m. and 7:00 a.m.
- 5. Recyclable materials including glass, plastic, and aluminum shall be picked up on the same Wednesdays that the Borough has town-wide pick-up for same. Pick-up at said institutions or schools shall be between 6:00 a.m. and 7:00 a.m.
- 6. Recyclable materials including newspapers, magazines, and cardboard shall be picked up on the same Wednesdays that the Borough has town-wide pick-up for same. Pick-up at said institutions or schools shall be between 6:00 a.m. and 7:00 a.m.
- 7. The term of this Agreement shall be for a period of one (1) year commencing July 1, 2020 and terminating June 30, 2021.

8. The Board shall pay the Borough the sum of \$18,289.00 per year payable in the amount of \$9,144.50 payable on or before December 31, 2020 and \$9,144.50 on or before June 30, 2021 during the term hereof.

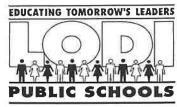

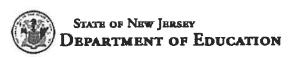

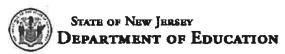
